

HOPE CITY EXPERIENCE (HCX)

Hope City Experience (HCX) is a four-month apprenticeship program during which participants work alongside our staff, learn Hope City systems and processes, and execute both weekly and weekend tasks/routines. The program exists to train up future Hope City leaders for opportunities to lead at a high level. Since the launch of the program in September 2020, we have graduated four classes of participants who have benefited in various ways from its offerings. In 2021:

- 166 applicants applied
- 29 applicants were chosen
- 23 participants were hired

HOPE CITY INTERNSHIP (HCI)

Hope City Internship (HCI) is a three-month paid internship program designed for participants to hone their skills, gain greater insight into ministry, and discover their capacity to lead and serve. In the 2021 Spring:

- 77 applicants applied
- 32 applicants were chosen and completed the program

The Local Missions lane allows Hope City to reach and meet the needs of our local community by partnering with local organizations that serve the greater Houston area. The overarching goal of the many Serve projects we offer is to shower people with the hope and love of Jesus.
