Scripture

Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.
Romans 12:12

When all the people were being baptized, Jesus was baptized too. And as he was praying, heaven was opened.
Luke 3:21

Main Idea

God doesn't deliver to "I Don't Believe Boulevard," but He always shows up on "Faith Street." Jesus had a reputation for being a man of prayer. It was His lifestyle. It was not only what He did but who He was. As believers, we must build our spiritual house on Faith Street through prayer.

Additional Scripture: Luke 3:21

How much room are you making for prayer? What does that look like?

PRAYER FUELS MY FAITH.

Additional Scripture: Romans 4:18-21

Are there any indicators that my faith is weakening or running on fumes? What am I willing to do to ensure that, like Abraham, my faith doesn't weaken or waver?

RIGHT TIME, RIGHT PLACE.

Additional Scripture: Ecclesiastes 9:11

What have been the occasions in your life when you were in the right place at the right time? How does prayer set us up for those moments?

PRAYER KEEPS ME GROUNDED.

Pastor Brandon talked about living in the gap between thankfulness and faithfulness. What are the things you are thankful for that you are allowing to feed your faith?

HE'S ALREADY ON THE WAY.

Knowing that God is already on the way, what miracle do you need?

Summary

Momentum is having the faith to believe whether it happens or not. As we make room for prayer in our daily routine, heaven opens up, and God shows up. It fuels our faith. Prayer keeps us content in the gap, reminding us to be thankful for where God has brought us and full of faith for where he's taking us.
