# Main Idea

I truly believe God is often looking to see how we steward what's not ours so that He can find out what He can give and trust us with. When you walk with the Lord, there should be some sort of evidence. That's oftentimes seen through our generosity and through our compassion for others.

### **Anchor Verse:**

"Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not people" (Ephesians 6:7, NIV).

# Generosity - Helps Us Become More Like Jesus.

You simply cannot become more godly without becoming more generous. The Lord wants us to become more generous so that we can become like Him.

Read Psalms 37:21; Acts 20:35

Read Philippians 2:3-4; Proverbs 1:19

### **Generosity - Helps Us Deepen Our Relationships**

Giving will always draw you toward whoever you're giving to.

Read Matthew 6:21

How have you seen your heart follow your treasure?

### **Generosity - Helps Stretch & Strengthen Our Faith**

One of The biggest ways God tests our Faith is through our Time, our Talents & our Finances.

Read 1 Corinthians 9:10-11; Romans 10:17; Hebrews 11:6

Where does your faith need to be stretched and strengthened?

### **Generosity - Unlocks Increase In Our Lives**

God wants to bless us, and He has set things in motion so that we will be blessed when we follow His will.

Read Psalm 112:5; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Where do you see the principle of sowing and reaping at work in your life?

### **Generosity - Is Connected To An Eternal Investment**

Even the best investments in this life only last one lifetime. But when we sow into an eternal investments the blessings never end.

Read Hebrews 3:4

Where are you investing and what do you foresee as its return?
